## THE EMBRACE PROGRAM

The World Service Association sponsors, through donations and pledges, the education of underprivileged youth in India.

The Embrace Program is administered by the Institute of Global Education, which has United Nations ECOSOC status.

The Embrace Program was founded in 1993 and operated by the late Ruth Schneider. Currently it is being directed by her husband Dr. Richard Schneider, the CEO of the Institute of Global Education, IGE.

At a very young age youth from remote villages in India were given the opportunity to learn in a non-caste environment. All received basic education, learning to speak three languages, and have since moved on to receive Bachelor's or Nursing Degrees. Others are presently in University to obtain their Master's Degree.

These students will become leaders in their communities. The graduates tithe back to the Embrace Program in order to give other youth a similar opportunity.

A vision of the Embrace Program is to equip a classroom bus, which will travel to remote tribal villages to train local teachers to become the teachers in their communities.
